In line with our behaviour and curriculum policy, we are always looking for ways to reward good behaviour and enhance the learning opportunities offered.

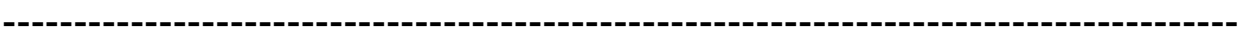
